Director of Cultivation Lee Bossard started his journey as a hobbyist grower back in 2008 before making the jump to commercial in 2014 and joining High Grade. Now, with over ten years of experience on a commercial level, Lee's leadership and knowledge have helped establish High Grade as one of the most trusted names among customers and dispensaries across Arizona.

Of course, with success and growth comes new challenges. As High Grade evolved and scaled up from 30,000 sq ft to 120,000 sq ft, continuing to hand water as they'd done it in the past was too labor-intensive now. On top of that, the reliability and cleanliness of the growing medium they were using at the time led to continuous problems and slowed progress at various stages of growth. So, they invested in their business and installed drip irrigation throughout their facility, allowing them to have less water each cycle, become greener, and make the switch to a cleaner, more dependable growing medium like Pargro.

Controlling WC & EC in the Rootzone

Before trialing and switching to Pargro, High Grade had difficulty maintaining the desired WC & EC in their blocks, mainly due to the inconsistencies and overall poor quality of the stone wool they used. The growing media wouldn't hold water, so the team had to water more often, even at night. This meant they had to trigger night shots just to keep the blocks above danger zones, which we all know isn't recommended.

"We all know you don't water at night, but we had no choice. We had to do night shots to keep the blocks above the danger zones. With Pargro, we don't have that problem. The stone wool is much more consistent and controllable."

As a result of the nightly irrigation events, the crew started noticing guttation on the plants in the morning, and although this isn't harmful to the plants, it can lead to an ideal environment for mold or mildew to develop, which can impact the quality and consistency of your final product.

Once in Pargro, Lee and the crew immediately had greater control of WC & EC in the rootzone, no longer having to water at night, and eliminated the guttation they were experiencing. With greater control, a deeper understanding, and a cleaner environment, High Grade learned to crop steer with precision, leading to a notable increase in yield and overall quality of their cannabis.

"Once we did make the switch, everybody on the High-Grade team was on board and excited about the root growth, overall plant growth, and most of all, the consistency of the final product."





Crop Steering with Pargro

Learning to steer each cultivar with more precision continues to be the goal at High Grade. Thanks to Pargro's ease of use and controllability, Lee and the team have already begun developing and perfecting recipes and experimenting with new strains and emerging trends with cutting-edge genetics. Now more than ever, with the cost per gram decreasing and the need to stay competitive, finding a way to connect and gain the trust of customers is the name of the game. Using crop steering methods, High Grade manages plant growth by adjusting its irrigation and climate to achieve the desired response from its plants. Allowing them to steer more vegetative and generative depending on the stage of growth while keeping the plants in balance, using fewer resources, and, in some cases, shaving time off each cycle.
